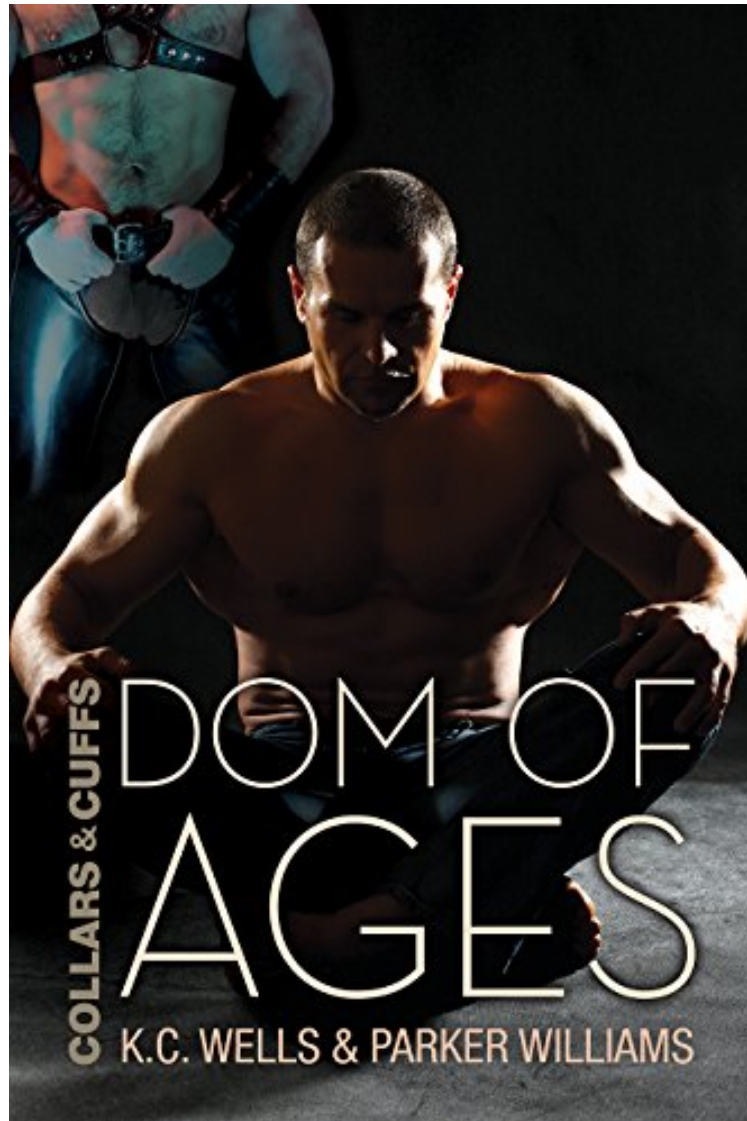

around in their huge house by himself, keeping it in order for a master who will never return. 4 years later he dares go to a club once more, but many things have changed. It's not about true submission anymore, the club members just dabble in BDSM and Jarod is twice the age of all the other subs. Eli has been wishing for someone to take care of him, a sub to live with him for a while but never met the right person. When he sees Jarod kneeling with the other subs, the only one with perfect posture and behaving like a submissive should, he decided to take him home. Though both Jarod and Eli want the same thing, it's not as easy as it sounds. Eli is not very experienced as a Dom, Jarod is still not done grieving over Philips' death and when they try going out to a club the encounter prejudices and rudeness due to their age difference. After a dramatic situation they finally start communicating better and decide to try Collars Cuffs as a new club for them both. Here they both, but Jarod especially find the acceptance he so desperately needs. But as Jarod starts to fall for Eli his doubts awaken: due to their age difference there is a strong likelihood he will go before Eli and leave him alone, just as he was left alone by Philips. Jarod loves Eli too much to want to put him through this and he sees only one solution: to not let Eli get attached. This is a wonderful book and it's my favorite. I really like the first three books as well but what I enjoyed with this one in particular is the bond between Eli and Jarod, the friendship between Jarod and the other subs (reconnecting us to Alex, Peter, Scott and all the others) and last but not least the way that Jarod and Eli take turns taking care of each other, both needing the other and his strength equally. Before I start I have to say that I have only read one other book in the series, so maybe jumping in at the end was not the best of ideas. Although it didn't interfere with the understanding of the plot, all the characters of the earlier books appeared, and it took a little bit of sorting out who was who and with whom. That aside, I did like both, Jared and Eli. For some reason I can't put my finger on, however, their story did not really resonate within me as soundly as it did with other readers. I have been trying to figure out why, and the only reason I can come up with is that for most of the book I don't feel that strong inner connection between them we are told about. They live together in a sub/dom relationship and then start falling in love slowly and gradually. To me, this process was too subtle. I couldn't feel it to an extent that it made my heart tighten and pound faster on their behalf. Okay, the sex scenes were hot (and different, very eye-opening in bits) and the humour throughout made me chuckle on lots of occasions, but I missed being part of Eli (in particular) falling in love. It is a little bit more obvious with Jared. But much more could have been made of this. I have no idea how accurate Collars and Cuffs is to a real BDSM club, and I have no idea what the life style involves on a day to day basis. I'm sure Ms. Wells has researched this thoroughly and knows what she's talking about. For my part I have no problem with a sub/dom relationship in bed, but find it very difficult to translate that idea into everyday life. Jared kneeling in the kitchen, next to the sofa etc. and being so subservient almost hurt. I guess it is up to every couple how they define their BDSM relationship, but for me Jared's interpretation was very extreme. I am not judging here, btw, just voicing my personal view. I know Jared was very happy with what he was doing and that is what counts in the end. I have to say my vote for my most favourite character in the book goes to Maggie. I love that woman and her brilliant humour. I love how she manages to put blushes on men's faces and render them speechless.
