At their first meeting they clash against each other and can't stop. While Dominic teases her and drives her crazy, she yells, screams, throws things at him or hits him. Bronagh, actually a self-imposed outsider who wants to be invisible to others after the death

of her parents, comes out of her shell. They fall in love with each other and know that it is meant for eternity. Before they can live happily ever after, Dominic's family businesses come between them and they have to be solved. I really liked the story. I connected with the characters, felt their emotions and couldn't put the book away. For a 5 stars rating I miss the urge to read it all over again. The story is written in Bronagh's perspective and the spelling style is very detailed and vivid. At a time when I dismissed environmental descriptions from contemporary romance novels, I read a lot of them and Casey's Dominic is no exception. Casey is born, raised and lives in Ireland. Her story is set in Dublin and her characters are Irish. It is consistent that she uses Irish vocabulary to write the story based in Ireland. It gives the story a special charm. Ok, Dominic is a story with a new student at school who brings the bereaved protagonist back to life. I mentioned in other reviews that I can't understand why authors don't use an existing student to save the girl but I respect the author's choice. The choice fits perfectly. The story is divided in two storylines. At first it describes the way to Bronagh's and Dominic's love, sex and relationship and then continues with Dominic's problems with his family businesses. It is the first story I read with weight issues. Dominic is different from other romance novels I read in the past. Bronagh and Dominic are constantly fighting. She is too stubborn. He is too possessive. A combination that causes trouble because Bronagh is a very strong and independent girl who doesn't take orders from men. She is glib and nimble-witted. She says what she thinks and can stand her ground. Fortunately, Dominic is man enough to handle her and their frictions are entertaining. However, she has an issue with the size of her butt. She feels insecure about it because the school's heartthrob made her insecure in the past and bullied her because of it. It needs Dominic who loves her completely and in particular her butt to boost her self-esteem. Dominic is a typical alpha male. He is self-assured, protective, possessive, knows what he wants and he wants Bronagh. At my age it is kind of strange to read an 18-year-old character who says he will f*** his girlfriend into submission. It seemed kind of odd. Do 18-year-old alpha males exist?
