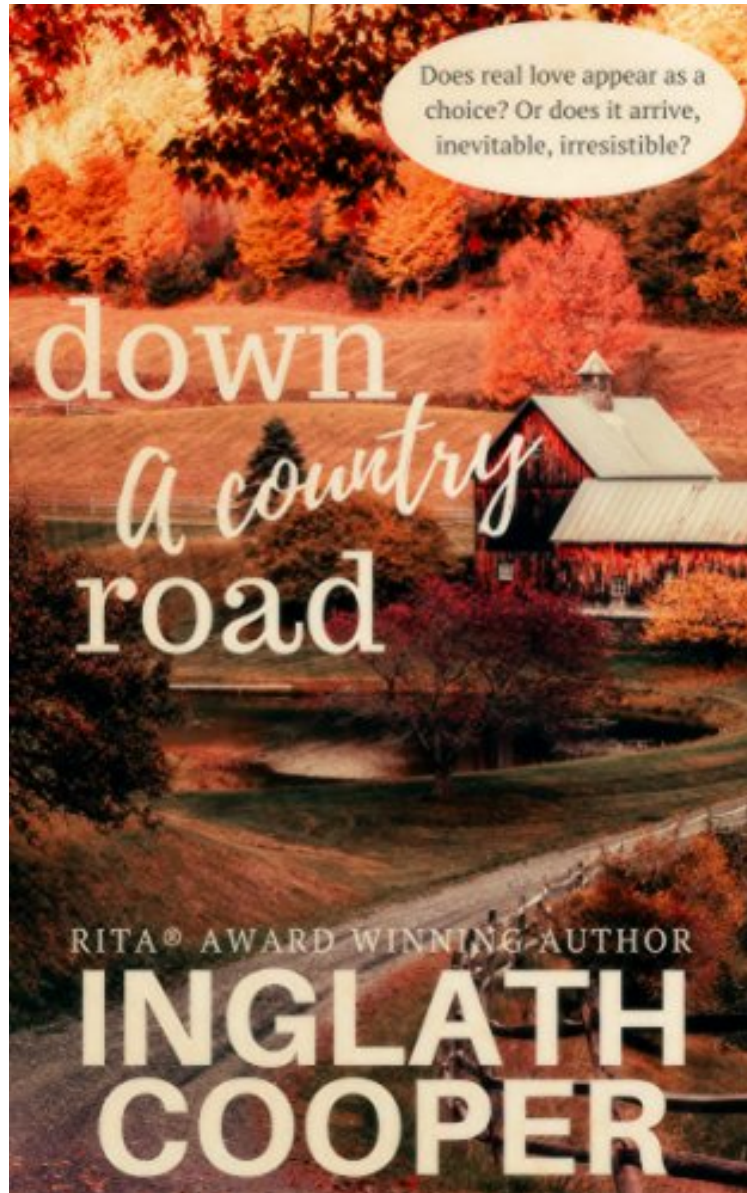

dieses Buch einfach nur von einer ganz normalen Liebesgeschichte. Gleichzeitig ist es auch eine Geschichte von jemandem, der heimkommt in einen Ort aus der Vergangenheit, den diese Person eigentlich nie wiedersehen wollte. Und es geht ums Vergeben, Vergessen, Verzeihen und um einen Neubeginn, was an sich ja alles schöne Dinge sind. Doch mich haben die vielen Nebenakteure und ihre Geschichtchen ständig von der Hauptgeschichte weggelockt. Ich vermute mal, das sollte so nicht sein. Die Nebendarsteller sollten nur die Szenerie bereichern und ein wenig Auflockerung hereinbringen. Mich haben sie aber völlig aus der Hauptgeschichte gebracht und leider muss ich sagen, war das nicht schwer. Keine der beiden Hauptfiguren der Liebesgeschichte hat mein Herz erwärmen können. Es war mehr so, als wären sie für mich emotionslos und gleichzeitig gingen sie in den Nebendarstellern unter. Irgendwann habe ich mich von den Nebendarstellern ferngehalten und mich nur noch um Grier und ihr Befinden gekümmert, damit ich zumindest die Hauptgeschichte gedanklich zu Ende bringen konnte (den die Nebenhandlungen/Erzählungen habe ich irgendwann nicht mehr sortieren können. Es waren einfach zu viele.). Dazu kommt noch, dass diese Szene am Anfang jedes Kapitels mich irgendwie aus dem Lesefluss brachten. Die Kapitel selbst sind schon nicht lang und dann denkt man im nächsten geht es interessant weiter und landet erst in einem ? bedeutungsschwächeren Satz, der aus dem besagten Blog zitiert wurde.
