The best of the books, but still not knocking me off my socks Von Mina Note: this being number three in a trilogy [I know there are more books, but the first three cover one story arc], makes it a bad place to start reading. If you're interested in reading the series, I recommend to start at the beginning with Dragon Marked. Review The books got better with each installment, but nevertheless the flaws are still preventing me from fully enjoying the book. The plot is told rather easily and not a real surprise, if you've read the first two books: Larkspur the infamous dragon king kidnapped Jessa and this being the finale, there has to be an endgame. And this is mostly, what it is: the road to the final battle. And of course on the way to said showdown there is a lot more information to be gained. About the dragon king, the dragon marked, the dragon mated and so on. And the background info is actually rather entertaining and inventive, although I wished it weren't told so blatantly instead of shown. What I did like were the loads of action and forward momentum and how the epic battle was described and stuff was wrapped up. It was pretty cool. The relationships and characters as a whole are still a weak point for me. And even the relationships I liked, that of Jessa with the Compasses and especially Braxton, did not feel as genuine and intense as before. Maybe because those relationships didn't play as huge a role as before, I don't know. But what did not change was how faux Jessa's relationship for example with her twin Mischa felt [and don't get me wrong: Mischa is so so dumb, really, can't stand her]. None of it felt real, especially since I totally disapprove of the magical bond that just magically is there and you feel the totally strong bond of sisterhood towards a person who not only appeared in your life just a few weeks ago, but who also betrayed you in the worst way possible. Nope, not believing it. [Same as I don't get the Louis, I barely know you, but now you are my chosen big brother. Just no.] Jessa's erratic choices and behavior are also as bad as before: no, right now best not shift into dragon.... and seconds later: alrighty now, like two minutes later, it would be best to totally shift just about now! What!?! These inconsistent decisions are a signature feature of all three books. And now that the endgame is on, the deus ex machina solutions are kind of overflowing. Whenever you could do with a handy new magic ability, tatataaaaa, it's there. Well, I'm sure it was before and just no one remembered to mention it. Or something.
